## Coronavirus (COVID-19) Notice

The Lowell Housing Authority continues to monitor the outbreak of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). We are taking the following preventative actions to help reduce the spread of this virus within our developments and ask for your assistance.

- Cleaning Practices: Our property management team has increased the disinfecting of high touch areas including doorknobs, vending machines, railings and bannisters, elevators and bathrooms. This same practice of cleaning with disinfectants should be done in our homes and vehicles for all high touch areas including doorknobs, handles, counters and phones.
- Limited Gathering Areas: Please assist us by refraining from gathering in entry lobbies. These areas should be used in short frequencies while waiting for a ride or delivery. The lobbies and entryways should not be used for visiting, recreation or social activities. We want to keep these areas clean and clear to reduce the possibility of contamination to our residents and visitors. Residents should congregate in established community rooms or units.
- Limit Contact with Others: We urge residents that may be ill to minimize or avoid contact with other residents, LHA staff and members of our community. Please inform any LHA staff member of a sick family member before they enter your unit. Residents are encouraged to call or email your property management office instead of making face-to-face visits. If you are feeling ill, please call to reschedule meetings with LHA staff and contact your medical provider immediately.
- Update Contact Information: Please be sure our property management offices have a current and valid phone number and email address. We are monitoring the situation and want to ensure we have correct contact information to deliver any future messages.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain a healthy and safe environment. Informational bulletins will be posted throughout buildings with tips regarding sanitization, cleanliness, and other ways to avoid contracting an illness.
